Kids Life airs on Mondays at 4pm and a repeat of this show runs on the following Saturday at 10am.





For some time Riverland Life FM has had this project on our agenda, but getting an available and workable ground position and tower to get us started has not been straightforward. But we believe that it is time to push forward.

Brenton Reimann has been contracted as Project Manager to lead a team to facilitate the set up of a transmitter in Waikerie. Brenton and Claire Reimann (pictured right) live in Moorook with their three children. Brenton grew up in the Riverland, studied Electrical and Electronic Engineering at Adelaide University, and has lived around Australia and overseas while serving with Australian-grown youth and community development organisation, Fusion Australia.

We ask you to pray for this step of faith, that the Lord will bless the project and those involved so that all those living in and travelling through the western end of our broadcast area can enjoy a better signal.




PRAYER POINTS
